Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME to Eliminate the Minor in Information Technology

WHEREAS the deans of the Colleges of Applied Sciences and Arts, Business, Mass Communication and Media Arts, and Science agree to eliminate the Minor in Information Technology; and

WHEREAS the number of students declaring Information Technology as a minor is relatively low; only 47 students have graduated within the last six years; and the expenditure of \$3,789,996 is no longer cost effective; and

WHEREAS the elimination of this minor area of study will not affect the faculty, staff, or students, and students currently minoring in Information Technology will be able to complete their academic course within two years, at which time the program will be eliminated;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Faculty Senate recommend the RME to eliminate the minor in Information Technology.
