

FACULTY SENATE UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATION POLICY COMMITTEE

Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME to Change the Existing Bachelor of Science Degree in Food and Nutrition into Two Bachelor of Science Degrees in Human Nutrition and Dietetics; and Hospitality and Tourism Administration

WHEREAS the Department of Animal Science, Food and Nutrition in the College of Agricultural Sciences has proposed to establish two new Bachelor of Science degrees from the existing Bachelor of Science degree in Food and Nutrition; and

WHEREAS these two new B.S. degrees will be Human Nutrition and Dietetics, and Hospitality and Tourism Administration; and

WHEREAS this proposed change will give identity to these previous specializations under the B.S. degree in Food and Nutrition, thus increasing enrollment in and placement from these programs;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommend approval of the RME to change the existing Bachelor of Science degree in Food and Nutrition into two Bachelor of Science degrees in Human Nutrition and Dietetics; and Hospitality and Tourism Administration at Southern Illinois University Carbondale.
