The total number of the University's tenured and tenure-track voting faculty FTE for each of the 11 colleges listed below is added up to determine the total number FTE.\*

That number is divided by 30 to achieve anapportionment index. The number of tenured and tenure track voting faculty FTE in each voting unit is then divided by that index, and the quotient rounded to the nearest whole number, thereby determining the representatives from that voting unit. Each voting unit should have at least one representative. The total FTE below is supplied by Human Resources Data Control.
