Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME for the Modification of the Bachelor of Science Degree in Business and Administration to Create an Online Degree Completion Program, College of Business

WHEREAS an on-line degree represents a technological advancement that our University has demonstrated a strong interest in pursuing; and

WHEREAS an on-line B.S. degree in Business and Administration is designed to appeal to working and non-traditional students; and

WHEREAS this proposed on-line B.S. degree is designed for students who have completed an Associates Degree;

WHEREAS this will operate as a responsibility-center budgeted program, which therefore will add to the University's General Income Fund but will require no additional budgetary expenses;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommend the RME for the Modification of the Bachelor of Science Degree in Business and Administration to Create an Online Degree Completion Program.
