## Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME for the Addition of a Minor in American Studies within the College of Liberal Arts

**WHEREAS** there currently is no single program within SIUC that allows the study of America from an interdisciplinary perspective; and

**WHEREAS** a minor in American Studies would allow students to study America from the perspectives of their particular interests, drawing on classes from a variety of departments; and

**WHEREAS** most colleges and universities have American Studies programs, and SIUC does not, and the relevant courses tend to be popular and highly relevant for a liberal arts education; and

**WHEREAS** the goal of this minor is to teach students to become more critical and aware as American citizens; and

**WHEREAS** the English and History departments have agreed to share the staffing of the one new course that will be required, "Introduction to American Studies;" and

**WHEREAS** no initial budgetary costs are required because all resources already exist;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Faculty Senate recommend the RME for the Addition of a Minor in American Studies within the College of Liberal Arts.
