Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME for the Addition of a Fashion Stylist Specialization to the Fashion Design and Merchandising Major in the School of Architecture, College of Applied Sciences and Arts

WHEREAS a specialization in Fashion Style will provide students with valuable skills and an entry-level portfolio that will appeal to many employers; and

WHEREAS there currently are no schools in Illinois that offer a fashion stylist specialization; and

WHEREAS this specialization is expected to benefit enrollment and retention for the major of Fashion Design and Merchandising; and

WHEREAS no new faculty are necessary until enrollment in this specialization increases, at which time the increase in tuition dollars are expected to fund any new faculty that are needed;
