Final Report to the Faculty Senate AY 2010-2011

During the above period, the Faculty Senate Governance Committee brought the following matters to the Faculty Senate for action:

1. A resolution to increase the number of Senators from the non-tenure track constituency from two to six. This was passed and forwarded for further administrative action.
2. A special rule of order to allow electronic collection of ballots for the election of Faculty Senators. This was accepted and has become our normal procedure.
3. A resolution to reject a proposed change to Faculty Senate procedures regarding the submission of agenda items for actions. The resolution was accepted and the resolution calling for change was rejected.
4. Finally, the committee considered a change in the operating papers regarding the eligibility of faculty not associated with a degree granting unit. This was presented for debate to the Senate and referred back to committee for further debate.
