## UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATION POLICY COMMITTEE

Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME for the Addition of the Specialization in Wildlife Habitat Management and Conservation in the Forestry Major, College of Agricultural Sciences

**WHEREAS** habitat loss is one of the greatest challenges to natural resource conservation and is a growing field; and

WHEREAS there has been an increase in wildlife habitat-related interest, education, and training within the undergraduate population in the Department of Forestry; and

**WHEREAS** this specialization would be the only one in Illinois that specifically prepares students for careers in the conservation, restoration, and management of wildlife habitat; and

**WHEREAS** this specialization complements the proposed Wildlife Biology specialization recently approved for the Zoology program; and

**WHEREAS** this creation of this specialization has been endorsed by the Department of Zoology; and

**WHEREAS** no budgetary effects are anticipated as the Department of Forestry has the staff and curriculum to support this specialization;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate recommends the RME for the Addition of the Specialization named Wildlife Habitat Management and Conservation in the Forestry Major.
