Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME to Eliminate the B.A. in Design in the School of Art and Design, College of Liberal Arts

WHEREAS the faculty of the School of Art and Design have unanimously approved this plan, as has the College of Liberal Arts Council; and

**WHEREAS** elimination of the program will not affect current faculty or staff, and students currently enrolled in the program will be allowed to graduate in it;
