During the 2020-2021 school year UEPC considered and approved 17 RMEs, 1 NIU, and 2 admission policy changes which are outlined below:

UEPC considered and approved the following RMEs:

Add a minor in Recreation Leadership in the School of Human Sciences in the College of Health and Human Sciences.

Add a Specialization in Aerospace Engineering in the B.S. in Mechanical Engineering degree program in the College of Engineering.

Eliminate the Certificate in Paramedicine offered through the School of Justice and Public Safety in the College of Health and Human Sciences.

Add an Undergraduate Certificate in Paralegal studies offered through the School of Justice and Public Safety in the College of Health and Human Sciences.
