Final Report to the Faculty Senate AY 2010-2011

During the above period, the Faculty Senate Governance Committee brought the following matters to the Faculty Senate for action:

- 1. A resolution to increase the number of Senators from the non-tenure track constituency from two to six. This was passed and forwarded for further administrative action.
- 2. A special rule of order to allow electronic collection of ballots for the election of Faculty Senators. This was accepted and has become our normal procedure.
- A resolution to reject a proposed change to Faculty Senate procedures regarding the submission of agenda items for actions. The resolution was accepted and the resolution calling for change was rejected.
- 4. Finally, the committee considered a change in the operating papers regarding the eligibility of faculty not associated with a degree granting unit. This was presented for debate to the Senate and referred back to committee for further debate.
