

**UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATION POLICY COMMITTEE**

***Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME to Eliminate the Specializations in Digital Communications from the Departments of Cinema and Photography, Radio-Television, and Journalism in the College of Mass Communication and Media Arts***

**WHEREAS** the specialization in Digital Communications was introduced into the College of Mass Communication and Media Arts in 1999 to provide students with an opportunity to focus on the emerging area of digital technology; and

**WHEREAS** digital technology has now been integrated into coursework in all existing specializations in these departments; and

**WHEREAS** a separate specialization in Digital Communications is no longer relevant; and

**WHEREAS** no budgetary effects are anticipated from the elimination of this specialization;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Faculty Senate recommend approval of the RME to Eliminate the Specializations in Digital Communications from the Departments of Cinema and Photography, Radio-Television, and Journalism in the College of Mass Communication and Media Arts.
