***Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME to
Eliminate the B.A. in Design in the School of Art and Design,
College of Liberal Arts***

WHEREAS the general B.A. in design has been under-enrolled, and design faculty believe their students are better served by the B.F.A. programs in communication design and industrial design; and

WHEREAS the faculty of the School of Art and Design have unanimously approved this plan, as has the College of Liberal Arts Council; and

WHEREAS elimination of the program will not affect current faculty or staff, and students currently enrolled in the program will be allowed to graduate in it;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommends approval of the RME to eliminate the B.A. in Design in the School of Art and Design, College of Liberal Arts.
