Faculty Senate update May 23, 2022

RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION

- New student enrollment continues to look promising for the Fall 2022 semester.
 - With 13 weeks before the start of the semester, admitted students for the first-time college student group ("freshmen") continue to be up more than a third over the same point last year.
 - o Applications are up more than 18%.
 - Registration for fall 2022 is showing an increase in numbers over this point last year, although the final number will not be official until the 10th day of classes.
- On campus transfer student applications and admissions are down but registrations are up; off-campus/online transfer student numbers are all up.
- Graduate student applications and admissions are down.
- Two New Student Orientations have been held with more than 300 students signed up to attend. More are scheduled throughout June.

RESEARCH

- The return of the Student Creative Activities and Research Exposition is scheduled for Sept. 20, 2022 from 1-4 pm in the Student Center Art Gallery. This is an opportunity for faculty, schools, centers and programs to highlight opportunities for undergraduates to get involved in faculty mentored research / creative activity. - The 2022 SIU Collaborative Grant for Health-Related Research RFP will be issued this summer with a deadline of Sept. 12, 2022.
- The new Vice Chancellor for Research and Graduate School Dean will be announced on Thursday, May 26.
